Admission to Visa Process - Steps

- File is opened, and an agreement is signed between Eduwise and the student.
- Same-day application is submitted to a listed college/University.
- Receive the offer letter (within a Mimi. of 20 to 45 days).
- Student Pay tuition fee to University (If Required) & Student get Letter of acceptance (LOA) from University
- Student submits all required embassy documents to Eduwise.
- Eduwise reviews all documents and prepares the file.
- Eduwise all required documents uploaded IRCC/CIC portal for Visa
- Student gets Bio-Metric letter within 7 days & Eduwise arrange VFS Appointment for Bio-Metric
- Student provided Bio-Metric to VFS
- Student waiting for VISA Decision
- Receive Visa approval & passport submitted to VFS.
- Student collects Passport from VFS & Pay tuition fees (If Required) and service charges.
- Fly to destination
